Parent Letter re: 2024 Summer Food Service Program

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Schenectady's Camp Lovejoy is participating in the Summer Food Service Program. Since the majority of the campers meet the eligibility guidelines below, meals will be provided to all children free of charge. Children who are part of households that receive food stamps or benefits under the Food Distribution Program on Indiana Reservations (FDPIR), or Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) are automatically eligible to receive free meals. The following income eligibility standards will be used for determining eligibility for free meals:
