Make an impact

Corporate Partnerships make it possible for us to continue, improve and expand the important programs that have a direct impact on the lives of Boys & Girls Club members. Our programs focus on three categories that have been identified as critical to helping youth positively develop: Academic Success, Good

Character & Citizenship, and Healthy Lifestyles.

Academic Success

- 94% of youth are on grade level for their age
- 91% (ages 9-18 years old) expect to graduate from high schoo (National graduation rate is 65-70%).
- 83% report missing three days or fewer during a full school year
- 86% report an expectation to attend college.

Good Character & Citizenship

- 92% report they have developed leadership skills
- 90% have had zero involvement with the juvenile justice system in the last 12 months.
- 89% report a civic responsibility and concern for their Community.
- 92% have set goals for their future.

Healthy Lifestyles

- 90% are engaged in physical activity at least three days per week
- 98% abstained from all tobacco products
- 96% abstain from the use of illicit prescription drugs

Overall Club Experience

- 94% of members believe that Club staff have high expectations for them.
- 81% report a better connection to adults.
- 84% report feeling recognized in their achievements.
- 87% of members feel a sense of belonging at BGCS.
